Helpful Hints:

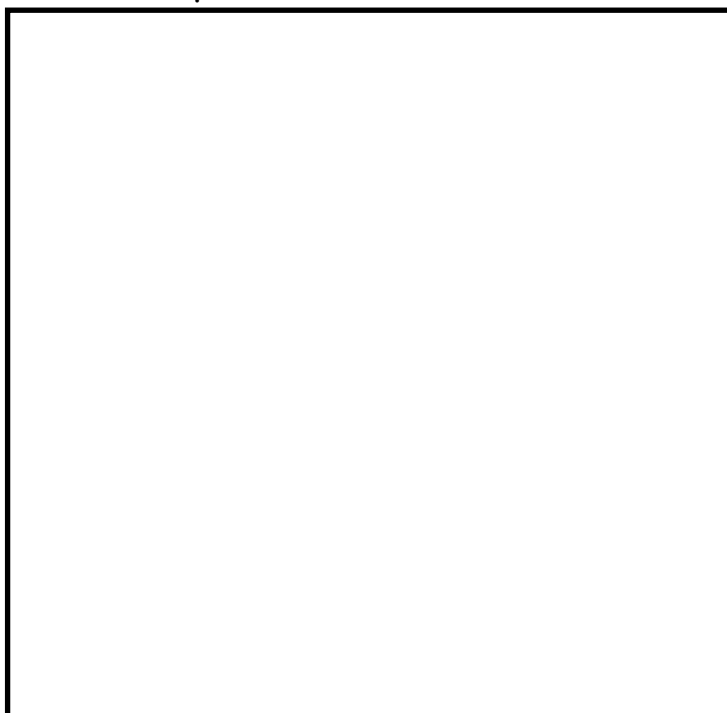
Atmosphere - the envelope of gases (or air) surrounding the earth.

Hydrosphere - all of the water surrounding the earth including on land and in the air.

Biosphere - all of the living organisms on earth and their environments.

Geosphere (also called **Lithosphere**) - the solid part of the earth consisting of rock, dust, soil, and related material.
